

**ILLINOIS PREVAILING WAGE ACT – ILCS 130/1 et seq.
BOARD RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted, “An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics and other Workers Employed in any Public Works by the State, County, City or any Public Body or any Political Subdivision or by anyone under Contract for Public Works,” approved June 26, 1941 codified as amended, 820 ILCS 130/1 et seq. (1993), formerly Ill. Rev. Stat, Ch. 48, par 39s-1 et seq. and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Streator Twp. High School District No. 40 of Streator, Illinois, LaSalle and Livingston Counties, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of LaSalle and Livingston Counties, employed in performing construction of public works, for said Streator Twp. High School District No. 40.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF STREATOR TWP. HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 40.

Section 1: To the extent and as required by “An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics and other Workers Employed in any Public Works by State, County, City or any Public Body or any Political Subdivision or by anyone under Contract for Public Works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics, and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the Streator Twp. High School District No. 40 is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the LaSalle and Livingston County areas as most recently determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department’s determination listed herein and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the Streator Twp. High School District No. 40. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

Section 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Streator Twp. High School District No. 40 to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

Section 3: The Secretary of the Board of Education shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the Superintendent’s Office of the Streator Township High School District No. 40 this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

Section 4: The Secretary of the Board of Education shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5: The Secretary of the Board of Education shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

Section 6: The Secretary of the Board of Education shall post on the public body’s website, a notice of its determination with a link to the prevailing wage schedule for that locality that is published on the official website of the Department of Labor, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
