Superintendent -

- <u>Chromebooks Purchase</u> Continuing with the Chromebook Initiative, the information submitted for the Board's review included 500 Lenovo 100e Chromebooks to be purchased for the 2018-19 incoming Freshman and Seniors. The total cost of the 500 Chromebooks is \$88,500.00 with \$62,500.00 to be paid from Title I funds and \$26,000.00 paid from the Chromebook insurance funds. Mr. Seaton recommended the Board approve the purchase.
- <u>Softball Field Netting Extension</u> In an attempt to control as many foul balls as possible, netting extensions between the softball field and the adjoining neighborhood homes has been recommended. The bid submitted by Haldeman-Hemme, Inc. in the amount of \$17,016.00 includes nets 35' tall and span an area of 40'. Mr. Seaton recommended the Board approve the bid from Haldeman-Hemme, Inc. for the amount of \$17,016.00 for the netting.
- <u>Activity Account JWA</u> The JWA Department has requested an Activity Account be created to manage funds generated by the JWA Program. Mr. Seaton recommended the Board approve the creation of the account.
- <u>Booster Groups Financial Protocols</u> Mr. Seaton provided the Board with a breakdown of the various Booster Group financial protocols. The Board discussed developing a policy that would require Booster groups to follow a choice of mandatory financial protocols in order to be recognized by the District.
